I am happy to provide this recommendation on his behalf.

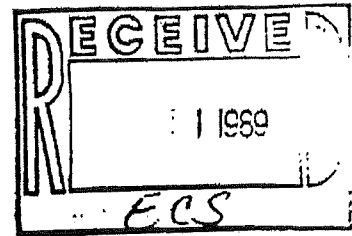
